## Do you own or manage land?

**If so you could benefit from grants and free advice for creating woodland or other habitat on your land. If you already have woodland, maintenance grants are also available.**

## Why are these grants offered and why should I be interested?

This financial help is offered to encourage the creation of woodlands near to where people live, to bring benefits to communities and nature. The grant rate varies depending on types of trees planted, location and public access, but can be up to £2800 per hectare. Woodlands can also provide opportunities for farm business diversification, either for wood products or by providing an attractive setting for recreation.

## How do I find out more?

The first step to getting more information is to pick up the phone and book a free site visit, with a member of The Mersey Forest Team visiting you and your land to discuss the possibilities. There are no strings attached and no obligation to proceed, just good solid advice to help you make up your own mind.
